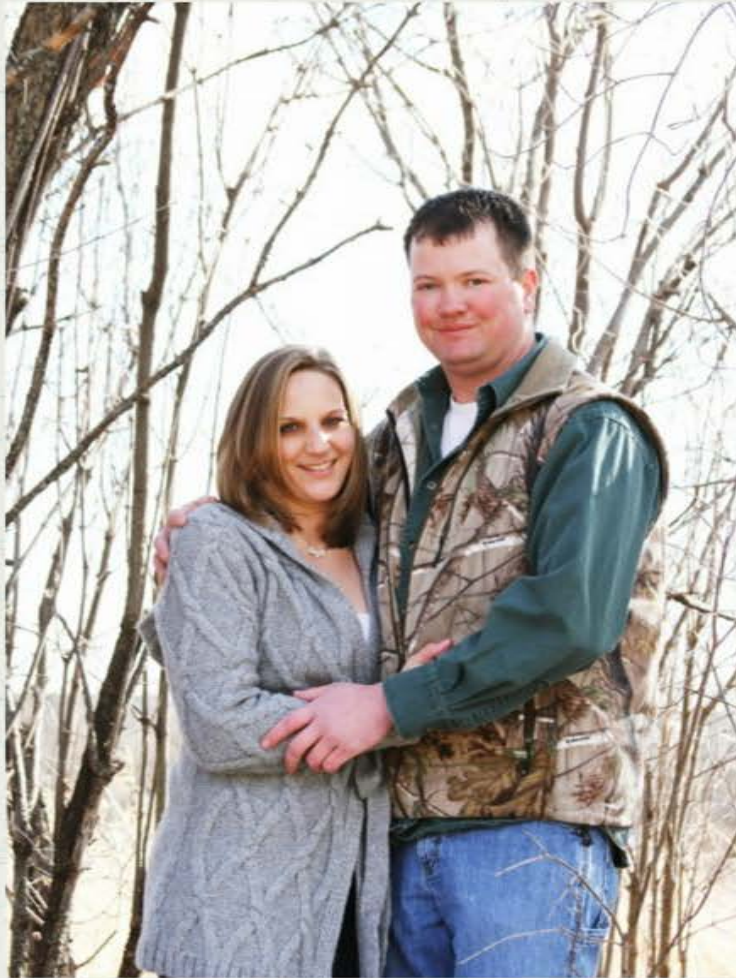

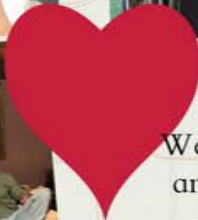


Dear birth parent,

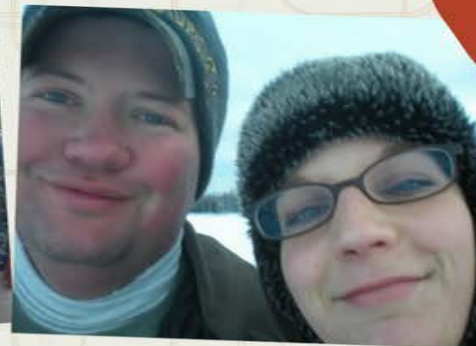
Our story
