Catholic Charities of the Diocese of La Crosse provides legal assistance to individuals who are eligible to apply for immigration benefits. The focus of the program is family based legal immigration services. Services include personal consultation, application assistance and legal representation for clients. Typical services include assistance in the following areas:

- Petition for relatives
- Adjustment of status
- Consular processing/Waiver applications
- Naturalization
- Work authorization
- Visa renewals
- Fiancé visas
- Applications for Victims of Crimes (U Visa)
- Applications for Victims of Domestic Violence (VAWA)
- Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA)
- Certificate of Citizenship
- Replacement green cards and employment cards
- Removal of conditions
