



No Wrong Door Coordinated Entry Agencies are for people experiencing homelessness or at risk of homelessness. We can help find housing and/or get connected to resources in the community.

Are you eligible? You might be eligible if your primary nighttime residence is a public or private place not designed for or ordinarily used as regular sleeping accommodations for people, including a car, park, abandoned building, bus or train station, airport, campground OR living in an emergency or domestic violence shelter.

The Good Shepherd Shelter provides a safe, clean, warm place for single men and women experiencing homelessness; affirms the Christ-like dignity in every individual through compassionate presence, listening and hospitality; and empowers people to rebuild their lives with the engagement of the greater community and respect.

The Good Shepherd Shelter started as an action step of the Wausau Housing and Homelessness Coalition, an initiative of the United Way. Catholic Charities operates the Center and works with United Way and other community organizations and volunteers to assure success.

VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

Meal Provider

The Meal Provider meets the need for a healthy, modest evening meal for 30-40 people. Food needs to be delivered to the shelter between 5:45–6:30 pm.

Evening Kitchen Crew

6:30–9:15 pm

The Kitchen Crew will prepare the kitchen, heat and serve the meal, and clean the kitchen.



Evening Intake Interviewers

6:00 pm–9:00 pm

The Intake Volunteers are essential to check in our guests each night. They inform guests of the rules/guidelines, assist in the shower/laundry schedule, and help the guests store belongings in a safe place.

Overnight Crew

9:00 pm–2:00 am

2:00 am–8:00 am

The Overnight Volunteer helps create a warm and dignified environment where one is able to get help meeting their basic needs of food, shelter and connection to a greater, caring community.

Morning Crew

5:00–9:00 am

The Morning Crew is needed to help with setting out breakfast items, assisting guests with their possessions, helping prepare guests for the weather with adequate clothing, and helping our guests get out the door by 8 am so that business hours can start at 9 am.
