The Beyond Shelter program links safe, affordable housing with flexible, voluntary support services designed to help the individual stay housed and live a more productive life in the community. 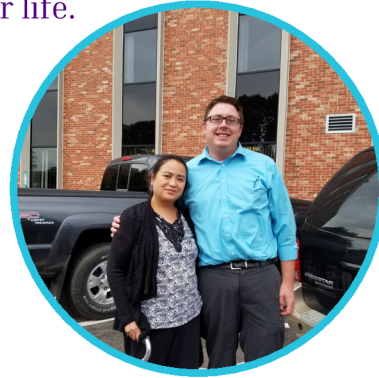
Catholic Charities certified and experienced staff will individually tailor assistance to each client. Struggling families and individuals will be able to receive an evaluation of their situation, develop a plan, participate in financial education and case management. We provide professional and confidential services that include: charitable assistance (rental, mortgage, food, utilities), financial counseling, housing counseling, mentoring programs and financial literacy. Our goal is to be an advocate for each client by providing support and guidance as they make a permanent change in regards to their relationship with money. We will work with the client to overcome their financial and emotional obstacles to clear a path to financial harmony.

Representative Payee Program

Our Representative Payee Case Managers provide confidential, compassionate assistance with budgeting needs and helping clients on a fixed income to meet their basic needs and reach future goals. Catholic Charities is approved to be an organizational payee through the Social Security Administration.

Disaster Response

Catholic Charities provides disaster relief and recovery services including emergency food, shelter, direct financial assistance, and recovery support. We have staff available to help you maneuver your way back to your pre-disaster life.



Immigration Assistance

Catholic Charities provides direct legal assistance to all immigrants for naturalization, adjustment of status, DACA, immigration services under the VAWA program (Violence Against Women Act), and other immigration services. In addition we provide all immigrants general assistance and/or referrals for special needs.

Adoption

For over 75 years Catholic Charities has been building families; helping them welcome a domestic or international child. In 2010, we became a Hague Accredited Program and maintain the Hague Accreditation necessary for international adoptions.

Pregnancy Support Services

Catholic Charities offers compassion and support to expectant birth mothers and fathers. Whether they choose to parent their baby or make an adoption plan. There is a free, confidential, 24/7 support helpline at 844-64GRACE (844-644-7223).

The Journeys Program

Offers supportive services that cover a wide continuum of needs for Wisconsin's adoptive & guardianship families, adult adoptees and birth families. This program is funded by a grant from the Wisconsin Department of Children and Families. Catholic Charities of the Diocese of La Crosse facilitates this program and it is built in collaboration with individuals, professionals, organizations and community members throughout Wisconsin who are impacted by adoption & guardianship.

Adult Day Services Program

The Adult Day Services Program offers a variety of opportunities for adults and those entering adulthood with developmental disabilities, those on the autism spectrum, and other special needs. Individualized services include assistance with social skills, pre-work skills, job skills and development, and independent living skills.

Community Based Program

This program works on skill building and recovery management for children and adults with mental health and/or substance abuse issues. We work with individuals to help them use community resources, work toward independence, and increase social skills.

Driftless Pass School

Our day school offers an alternative to public school for students whose needs are difficult to meet in traditional public school classrooms. Students who enroll may display challenging behaviors due to mental health needs, experienced trauma, Reaction Attachment Disorder or a diagnosis of Developmental Disability, as well as Autism Spectrum Disorders. Students may also have associated medical issues such as a seizure disorder that can complicate the education program.
