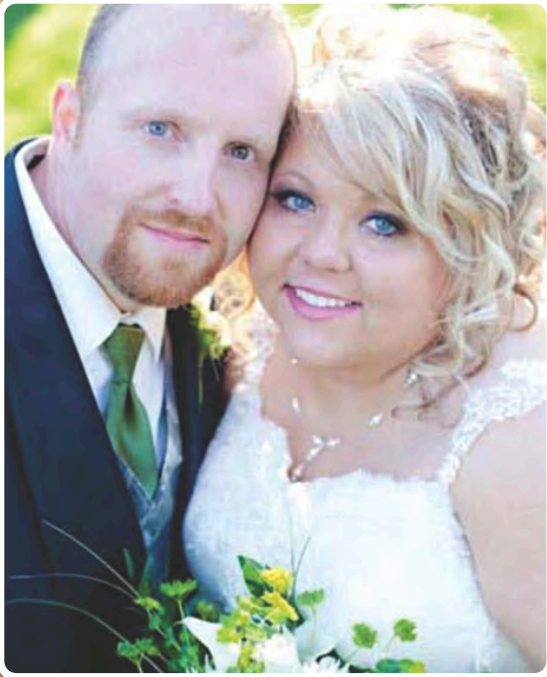

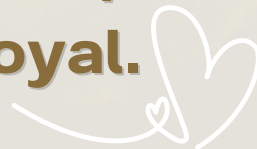

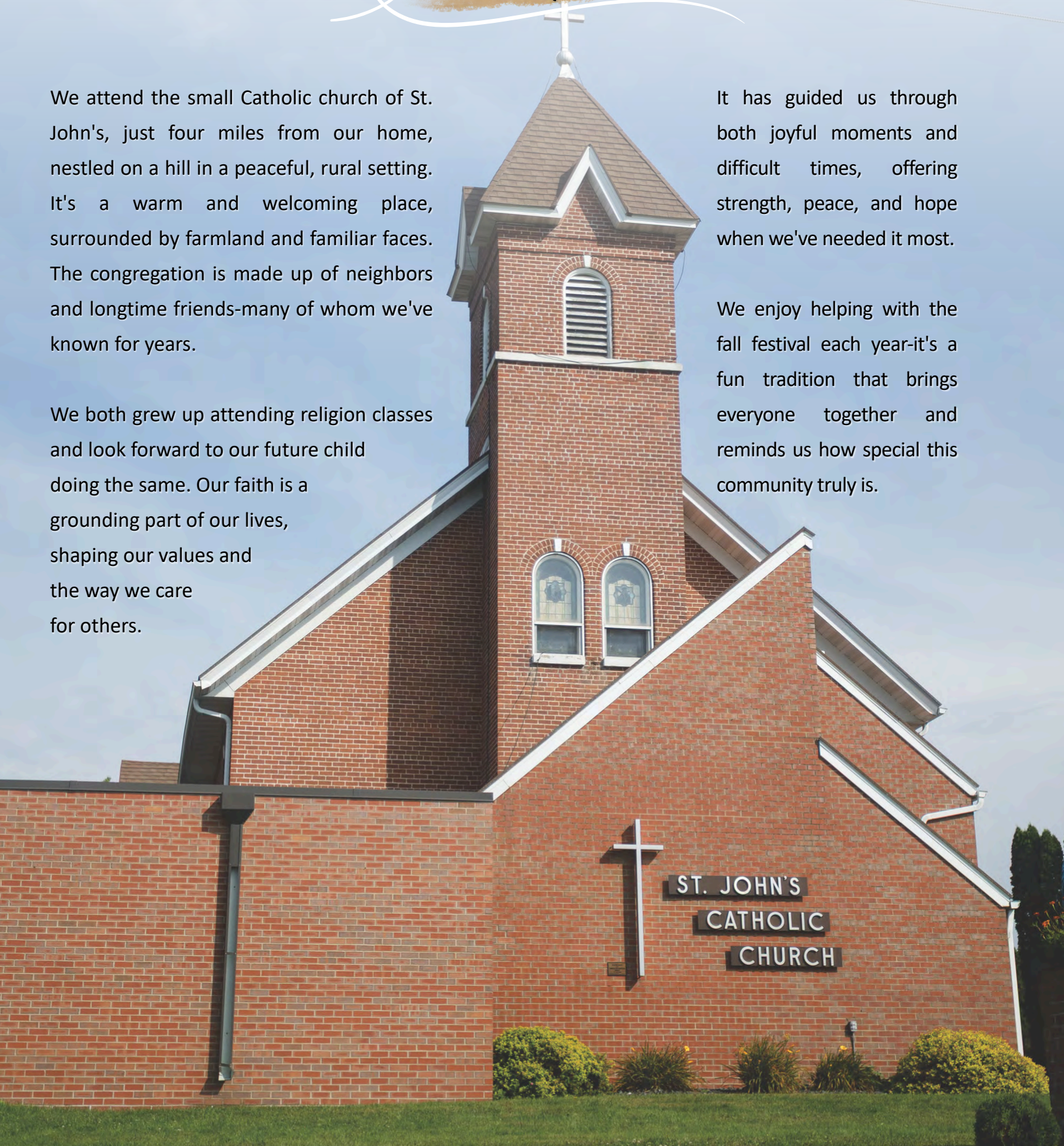
Faith

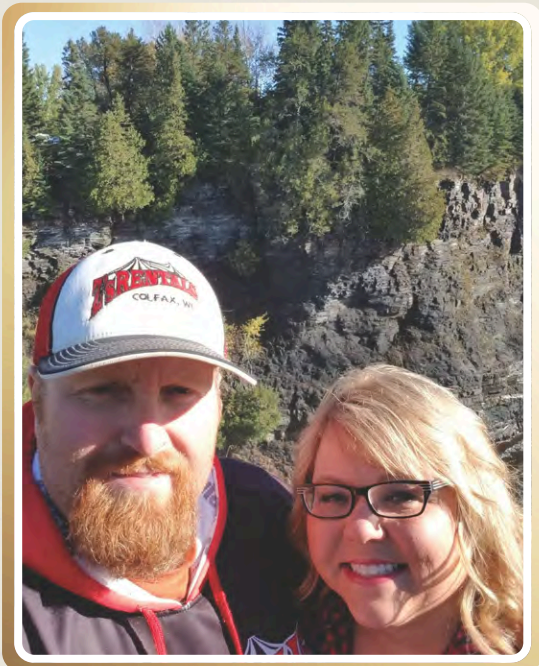

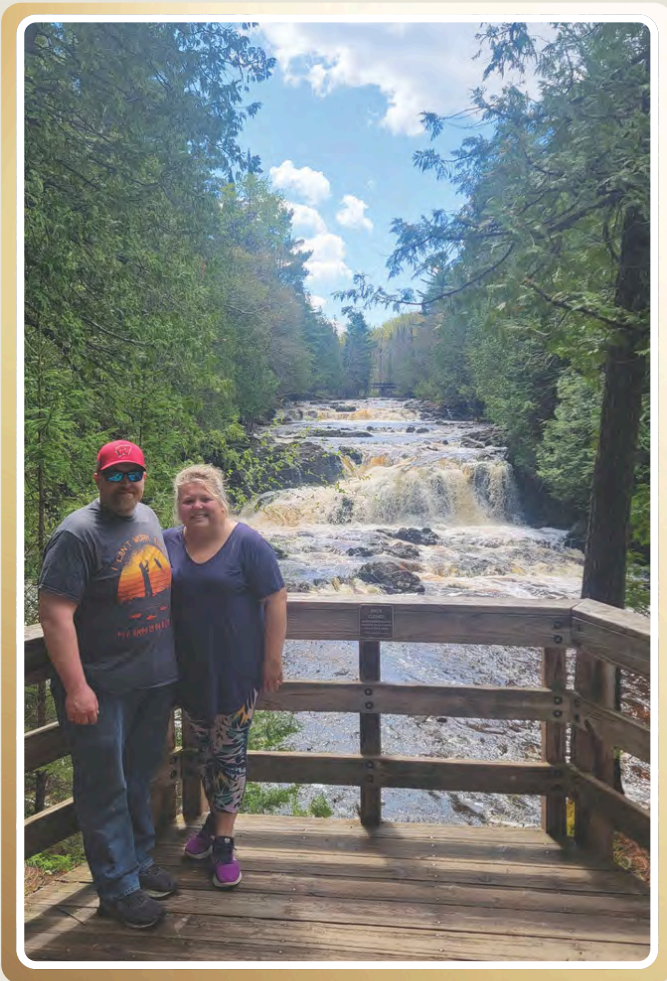
